



Dear Parade Participants,

The 94th Annual Donkey Derby Days Parade is on Saturday, June 28th @ 11:00am

If you would like to provide music on your float, that would enhance the event.

Please thoroughly read the parade rules and instructions!

Check in for the parade will be located at the intersection of A St./Bennett Ave, right by the Jail Museum.

Check-in time starts at 9:00am. I'll be wearing a t-shirt with "PARADE TEAM LEADER" on it.

At check in, you will receive your lineup number as well as a parade participation ribbon.

The lineup for the parade will start after check-in along Bennett between A Street and C Street.

The parade will start at the Jail Museum on Bennett and continue to 5th Street.

Please read the parade rules as per the city:

-Anyone driving a float or motorized vehicle in the parade must have a valid driver's license, and the vehicle must be adequately insured. Vehicle must be in working order and not create a traffic hazard.

-Candy, beads, and other items cannot be thrown during parades. Candy, tokens, and gifts can be handed to spectators by parade participants walking along the route, but not from vehicles or floats.

-Float participants cannot mount or dismount from floats during the parade.

-No alcohol or glassware is allowed in the parade.

For your convenience, parking for parade participants will be along Bennett Avenue, either side east of B Street and in the vacant lots between 1st Street and A Street on the south side. **Please reserve the first lot farthest to the west for use by participants with horse trailer.**

Please be respectful of others' property and don't block driveways or park on private property.
