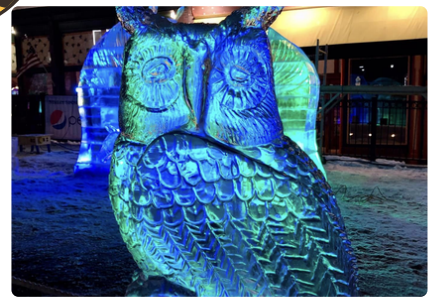
CLUB NEWS:
